

2026 TCHA Horse Camping trips – Revised 3/9/26

May 1 – 4 Dru Barner Horse Camp, Georgetown

No reservations

- \$8/night
- Several sites have 2 pens, water faucets are spread throughout the campground bring something to haul water to campsites
- Restrooms

June 12 – 15 Orick Rodeo Grounds, Orick in northern California.

- \$15/night per horse and \$5/night per person. Pay by cash or check when you arrive, no credit cards.
- To make reservations, call 707-601-4129. They will need to know the number of pens you need, your email address and phone number. They have 10 pens available as of 3/9/26.
- Make your reservations ASAP to assure you have a spot.
- There are no actual sites, just a large grassy field with few water faucets throughout the area. Basically, park where you want but be considerate of others.
- There is horse water near the pens.
- The grounds have pens and camping with direct access to the trails in the Redwoods and access to the nearby beach and river. Trails into the Redwoods are good but a climb. The trail to the beach is flat

July 9 – 13 Kennedy Meadows

- Approx \$125 for the weekend. This is a fund raiser for DEHA
- No assigned sites, camping is in an area behind Kennedy Meadows Resort, very basic!
- No pens, you must bring your own pens or highline
- Water is pumped from the river so bring something to haul water to your campsite.
- Dinners are usually potluck with all attending but not required. So plan accordingly.

September 25 - 28 Joseph Grant Park, San Jose

Make reservations at <https://gooutsideandplay.org/reservation/camping/>

Select Joseph P Grant as park, scroll down to list of horse sites

- 7 sites, sites have 2 pens
- Water at each site
- Sites include picnic table
- Manure must be bagged and placed in dumpster so bring plastic bags.
- Chemical toilets

October 9 – 12 Loafer Creek Horse Camp at Lake Oroville.

- Costs: \$45/night plus reservation fee.
- Make reservations at www.reservecalifornia.com, search for Lake Oroville SRA and equestrian sites. Due to the 6 month reservation window, you will not be able to make these reservations until April 9th.
- Campground includes showers, restroom, round pen, and wash rack. Each site includes a 2 stall pen, picnic table, bbq, etc. October will be beautiful weather. Trails are easy and mostly flat.
